ORDER

NO.MEST-91/133

Dated Itanagar, the 30th May/91.

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to accord approval to the prescription of the following guidelines to regulate nomination of serving doctors of Arunachal Pradesh to various post graduate/in-service training courses:-

- A.I. Non-obligatory short term training courses (of duration of 90 days or less) arranged by the Government
- (i) Preferably officers from the same discipline.
 - (ii) Selection should be made from the officers as per their seniority.
 - (iii) Officers having Rural-service/difficult area service will be given preference.
 - (iv) Once an officer is trained, he should not be deputed for another training within 3 years of previous training unless it is essential in the interest of public service.
- A.II. Non-obligatory short Term Training Course (of duration of 90 days or less) arranged by the Officer, may be allowed after completion of two years of service in the State, once in 5 years.
- B. For recognized courses of post-Graduate study like M.D, M.S, D.P.H, D.M.C.W and other degree/diploma course/Non Obligatory long term training courses (of duration of more than 90 days).
- B.I For Government Quota of seats (e.g Post Graduate seats in Regional Medical College, Imphal).

Eligibility:-

- 1.1 Officers should have 5 years service in the State.
- 1.2 Preference should be given to Arunachal Pradesh Health Cadre Officers
- 1.3 Officers having service in rural/difficult areas will be given preference
- 1.4 An officer should not be sponsored for another P.G study within 5 years of completion of the previous study.
- 1.5 An officer sponsored for such P.G study has to give an undertaking to serve the State for a minimum period of 5 years after completion of the study. They will be sponsored on duty, study leave as per Rules. Selection will be made from the willing candidate after observing the above mentioned criteria and as per their seniority in the service.

- B.II. For Officers who obtain seats by themselves through competitive examination or otherwise.
- (i) Officers who manage their own seats by competitive examination or otherwise may be allowed for the study on leave according to their eligibility.
- C. For Obligatory training: - Officers from the same discipline will be deputed for training on seniority and need basis.
Similar principles will be followed in case of other category of officers/staff of the Health Department also.
