

**CIRCULAR**

**Mode:** Wearing Black Badges/ Arm bands  
**Action:** President/ Gen Secy of respective Dists
2. **Date:** 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> August 2010  
**Mode:** Flash Dharna of 1(One Hour) from 10:30 am to 11:30 am  
**Action:** President/ Gen Secy of respective Dist.

**DO'S AND DONT'S DURING THE PROTEST**

**A. DO'S**

1. All in service doctors including administrative and program officers will participate in the proposed state wide protest as per the schedule.
2. Hospital services (OPD, Indoor, Emergency) will continue to function as usual during the first phase. However only OPD services during the flash one hour Dharna between 10.30 am to 11.30 am will be temporarily suspended.
3. Hospitals manned by single doctor is exempted from the flash one hour Dharna. But he/she will continue to wear black badges/ Arm band.
4. Banners, placards, posters should be displayed appropriately reflecting APDA grievances.
5. President/GS of respective Dist. Units should arrange:- Banner, poster, placards/Black ribbon/safety pin and others.

**B. DONT's**

1. Dist units shouldnot take arbitrary decisions without consulting central APDA
