**MEMORANDUM**

This is in continuation of the Govt. order No.MEST - 91/133 dated Itanagar, the 30<sup>th</sup> May' 1991.

The Govt. has prescribed the guidelines to regulate Nomination of serving doctors of Arunachal Pradesh to various post graduate/in-service training course vide order No.MEST-91/133 dated Itanagar, the 30<sup>th</sup> May' 1991.

In addition, it has been decided that 3 (three) years service in a rural posting is mandatory for such consideration.

In spite of such order many doctors have been recommended and forwarded to the Govt. for consideration of their cases for post graduate/in-service training courses even though these doctors not fulfill the prescribed norms.

Therefore, it is ordered hereby, to all concerned that henceforth no such applications should be forwarded and if any body forward such cases then the forwarding officer will have to bear the responsibility.

However, any body who wants to pursue higher studies may go on his own expenses after getting proper approval from the Govt. as permitted by the rules.
