Sub: **Retention of post of the Director of Health & Family Welfare as per APHS Rule 2000**

Sir,

With due respect and humble submission, the APDA would like to draw your kind attention to the above issue for your consideration and necessary action.

1. The Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension, Govt. of India, New Delhi, has recommended the Director of Health of Arunachal Pradesh to be taken over by IAS Cadre.**(Ref I)**
2. To this effect, the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh has notified an order **(Ref II)**, in which one IAS officer has been shown against the Director of Health.
3. The post of Director of Health and Family welfare, as per the provision of APHS Rule 2000 is exclusively for APHS Cadre and the eligibility for the same post is through promotion from the post of either Additional Director or Supertime Grade Specialist. This is reflected in the Schedule I, II and III of the APHS Rule 2000. **(Enclosure: A).**
4. The consensus of all the in-service doctors is that the post of Director of Health be reserved as per APHS Cadre Rule 2000 for APHS Cadre only. Any attempt by the Govt. to change this provision will invite a strong protest by the in-service doctors.
5. In view of the changing health scenario and rapid expansion of the Health Department, the APDA has proposed to the Govt. for overhauling the present APHS Rule 2000 and to create additional post of **Director of Medical Education and Training** for specialist Sub Cadre and **Principal Director of Health**, in order to streamline the administrative hassles of our department.**(Enclosure: B)**

In view of the above facts and circumstances, the APDA request to you to look into the matter and intervene accordingly in order to create a cordial atmosphere and to boost the morale of the in-service doctors.
